Testing Policy for Washington State Knowledge and Drive Test

All Adults and teens need to be fully aware of the policies for taking tests at the East Hill Driving School (EHDS).

Every applicant needs to have a photo ID or passport, and the fee; Knowledge test \$30 for two attempts within 30 days. Drive test; \$40 with costumer car, \$60 with school car for one attempt.

- Teens must present their completion certificate of Traffic Safety Education Course before they can take the drive test.
- All electronic devices must be turned off
- Only the applicant will be allowed in the testing area: in the classroom or in the vehicle.
- EHDS will not allow an intoxicated person to take test.
- To pass the knowledge test an applicant must answer a minimum of 32 questions correctly out of 40 questions.
- To pass the skill test an applicant must receive a minimum of 80 points out of 100 points.
- Your car must be legal to operate on public streets. This includes, but is not limited to: windshield, seat belts, wipers, defroster, tires, mirrors, all brake and reverse lights, turn signals and be legally licensed/tabs current. Applicants wishing to use their own vehicle for their skills exam are required to provide proof of insurance and current registration, (current tabs), on the day of the test. We will not refund for any tests taken. We will not refund for applicants who arrive unprepared including, but not limited to, failure to meet vehicle checklist requirements, expired insurance cards, lacking acceptable ID, late arrival, etc. Thus rescheduling a Drive Skills Test as a result of arriving unprepared will be the full **\$40** fee.
- You will need to demonstrate arm signals prior to beginning the skill test.
- We reserve the right to refuse services to anyone
- If you received a letter from DOL to take an examination due to a physical, mental, visual or any medical issue, you must test at a DOL office. Failure to disclose this information prior to testing will result in your test not being honored at DOL to obtain your license and we will not refund the test fee.
- Pursuant to RCW 46.20.720 a driver convicted of an alcohol offense may be required to have an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) in order to drive. The applicant must take the skills exam in their vehicle using the IID.
- To reschedule a drive test you should give a notice of 24hours before your appointment.

Scores of the knowledge and driving test will be reported to the Department of Licensing electronically within 24 hours. Passing the knowledge and driving test doesn't guarantee that an applicant will be issued driving license. The Department of Licensing will determine if an applicant has met all licensing requirements. The Department of Licensing reserves the right to conduct random re-examinations; applicants refusing to take a re-examination may have their license revoked.
