

Testing Policy for Washington State Knowledge and Driving Tests

The following policies apply to all adults and teens taking tests at East Hill Driving School (EHDS). Please contact us immediately if you have any questions or concerns. On arrival at your test appointment, you will be required to sign a form acknowledging that you understand and agree to these policies.

- Every applicant is required to have a photo ID or passport, and the appropriate fee. Knowledge test fee: **\$30** for one attempt. Driving test fee (for one attempt): \$50 with customer car, \$70 with school car.
- Teens must present their completion certificate of Traffic Safety Education Course before they can take the driving test.
- All electronic devices must be turned off.
- Only the applicant will be allowed in the testing area: in the classroom or in the vehicle.
- EHDS will not allow an intoxicated person to take a test.
- To pass the knowledge test, an applicant must correctly answer a minimum of 32 questions out of 40 questions.
- To pass the driving skills test, an applicant must receive at least 80 points out of 100 points.
- Your vehicle must be legal to operate on public streets. This includes, but is not limited to: windshield, seat belts, wipers, defroster, tires, mirrors, all brake and reverse lights, turn signals, and be legally licensed with current tabs.
- Applicants wishing to use their own vehicle for their skills exam are required to provide proof of insurance and current registration (current tabs), on arrival at their test.
- If a test is taken, there are no refunds.
- There is no refund for driving skills applicants who arrive unprepared including, but not limited to, failure to meet vehicle checklist requirements, expired insurance cards, lacking acceptable ID, arriving more than 7 minutes past the scheduled driving test start time, etc. Thus the fee to reschedule a Driving Skills Test due to arriving unprepared is the full \$40 fee.
- You will need to demonstrate arm signals prior to beginning the driving skills test.
- We reserve the right to refuse services to anyone.
- Any costumer with a physical, mental, visual, or any medical issue, must be tested at a DOL office. Failure to disclose this information prior to testing at EHDS will result in your test not being honored at DOL to obtain your license and EHDS will not refund your test fee.
- Pursuant to RCW 46.20.720, a driver convicted of an alcohol offense may be required to have an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) in order to drive. The applicant must take their driving skills test in their vehicle using the IID.
- To reschedule a driving skills test, you must contact us on a business day at least 24 hours before your appointment time in order to apply your fee to your new appointment time.

Scores of the knowledge and driving test are reported electronically to the Department of Licensing within 24 hours. Passing the knowledge and driving test doesn't guarantee that an applicant will be issued a driving license. The Department of Licensing will determine if an applicant has met all licensing requirements. The Department of Licensing reserves the right to conduct random re-examinations; applicants refusing to take a re-examination may have their license revoked
